**Compulsory School Attendance Law:**

118.15 (1)(a) Any person having under their control a child who is between 6 and 18 years shall cause the child to attend school regularly during the full period and hours, religious holidays excepted, that the public or private school in which the child should be enrolled is in session...

(3)(a) The school attendance officer may request the parent or guardian of the child to obtain a written statement from a licensed physician, dentist, chiropractor, optometrist or psychologist or Christian Science practitioner...as sufficient proof of the physical or mental condition of the child.

(b) Truancy means an absence of part of all of one of more days from school during which the school attendance officer principal, or teacher has not been notified of the legal cause of such absence by the parent or guardian of the absent pupil and also means intermittent attendance carried on for the purpose of defeating the intent of s.188.15.
