Student attendance is critical to academic success. We at Mahone Middle School take your child's attendance very seriously. We meet weekly to look at student attendance and follow up with families. If your child is ill and cannot be at school, please be sure to notify our front office at 262-359-8101. If you do not contact us, then your child is marked truant. Truancies can lead to legal issues, including a ticket. At Mahone we send out an initial truancy letter and contact the family if a child has two truancies. When a child reaches five truancies we send a habitual letter and begin paperwork with the court system.

It is important for your child to be here every day. We understand that sometimes a child is too sick to attend and needs to be excused. If a child gets seven excused absences, we send a letter home to inform the family the student is approaching excessive absences. At ten excused absences, we send a letter home notifying the family that we will stop excusing absences without a doctor's note. Unexcused absences count as truancies and can lead to legal issues, including a ticket. If your child is out of school and sees a doctor, please get a note from the doctor and give it to Mrs. Tinker in the front office when the child returns to school. This allows us to mark the absence as medical, and it doesn't count towards excused absences or truancies.

We care about your child. If your child is having issues causing them to miss a lot of school, please contact your grade level guidance counselor or myself and make us aware of the situation so we can help work through it together. Above all, we want your child to be safe and successful.
