You are applying to become a member of the National Junior Honors Society. In addition to participating in the Induction Ceremony, all students have certain responsibilities for maintaining membership in NJHS.

1. Members must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.5.
2. Members must complete twelve or more hours of community service by the end of the school year. This can be done through school, church, community or other service activities. You need to fill out a documentation slip (available in the front office or on the Mahone website) for your activities and turn it in before May 1st.
3. Members must demonstrate strong character and leadership through behavior and interaction with others. Behavioral referrals could be grounds for immediate dismissal from NJHS.

Being a member of the NJHS has both privileges and responsibilities. The listed requirements not only begin to demonstrate your child's commitment to the NJHS, but will also provide your child with good experiences as a person and as a member of the organization. If your child is willing to meet the above requirements, we look forward to their induction into the NJHS.
