Hours include service to school, church, or community – anything where you are not compensated for your service. The form for documenting service hours is below. New members will turn the slips in with their application in the spring. Hang on to them until then.

3. Members must demonstrate strong character and leadership through behavior and interaction with others. Behavioral referrals could be grounds for immediate dismissal from NJHS.
